New Contract Provision-Temporary Supervision Aide Seniority List

The July 1, 2022-June 30, 2025 collective agreement with the Vancouver School Board features a new clause for Supervision Aides who are working as Temporary Employees.

Modelled after the Operations and Cafeteria provisions negotiated in previous contracts the language creates a seniority list for temporary Supervision Aides. The immediate positive impact for temporary employees is that the Board won't be able to pick a brand new employee if a temporary supervision aide (or permanent) utilizes their seniority and applies for the position.

The new language in Appendix "A" reads:

30. Temporary Employee Service Accrual

Temporary Supervision Aides who have accumulated 450 paid hours over any twenty-four month period shall be placed on a Temporary Supervision Aide a seniority list with twenty-four (24) months seniority from the date they are placed on such list, commencing September 1, 2023.

Frequently Asked Questions re: Temporary Supervision Aide Seniority List

Has the first Temporary Supervision Aide seniority list with employees who worked 450 paid hours over any two year period been compiled as of September 1, 2023?

- A. Yes. The new list has been created with all Temporary Supervision Aides who qualified.
- Q. Why is there a twenty-four month credit of seniority?
- A. The granting of twenty-four months seniority for all Temporary SA's who qualify is a negotiated compromise to account for time worked as a Temporary Employee. Some Temps may have worked more than 24 months, some less.
- Q As a Temporary Supervision Aide with seniority on the Temporary SA list can I apply for all SA positions?
- A. Yes.
